- 3. To track supplies and communicate needs to campus admin.
- 4. To maintain written records as needed and requested by Director of Homes for Families.
- 5. To prioritize safety of children at all times while in care.
- 6. To interact with mothers, children, and groups in a manner consistent with Christian values.
- 7. To provide biblically sound training classes for moms and children to attend together.
- 8. To supervise and train Child Care Assistant.
- 9. To attend campus family trips to assist as needed.
- 10. To provide transportation to and from Camps, VBS and extracurricular activities that are off campus.
